# 31<sup>ST</sup> FLUTE ENSEMBLE COMPETITION 2025 Regulations

- Entries must be received by 28th April, 2025
- All ages as at 25th May, 2025
- Each ensemble will be notified by mail of the starting times of their sections and will be given a participation number.
  - It is the ensemble's responsibility to arrive at the venue in sufficient time to participate.
- Each ensemble <u>must supply the adjudicators with a copy of the full score of each work</u> being performed. Approximately every 5<sup>th</sup> bar to be numbered.
- Duets are for 2 flute players only playing different parts (or piccolo, Eb, alto, bass or contra bass flutes, sub or hyper bass flutes are acceptable).
- Duet plus One other instrument sections are to include 2 x flute players playing different parts (or piccolo, Eb, alto, bass, contra bass flutes, sub or hyper bass flutes).
   The 'other instrument' is not to be a flute related instrument.
- There is a minimum of three flute players in small ensembles and six flute players in large flute ensembles.
- Competitors must supply their own accompanist if needed.
   A professional accompanist may be used.
- A NOVICE group is defined as one of mixed age, and /or mixed ability, and /or a community based ensemble. No professional players allowed.
- Time limits as specified are maximum and must be strictly observed.
- If there are not enough entries in a section, the Ensemble Committee has the right to cancel that section or combine with the next age section.
- Each ensemble will receive a short review of their performance and a Certificate of Merit.
- The Adjudicators decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into regarding the adjudication.
- The Ensemble Committee reserves the right to resolve any disputes or questions regarding any regulations of the conduct of the competition.

#### **CONCERT PERFORMANCES**

The winners of each of the 22 sections may be invited to perform at the "Annual Victorian Flute Guild Concert and General Meeting" to be held in October 2025. Details to be advised.



## 31ST FLUTE ENSEMBLE COMPETITION

The Flute Ensemble Competition began in 1994 as part of the Melbourne Flutestival. Since then it has become an annual event and is becoming increasing popular for school, community and privately run flute ensembles.

C Small Flute Ensemble: 3 - 5 Performers - minimum 3 <u>flute</u> players
 D Large Flute Ensemble: 6 or more Performers - minimum 6 flute players

#### 10.15am: 14 Years and under - Maximum time: 6 minutes

E Duet: 2 flutes only

**F** Duet plus One: 2 flutes + one other instrument

G Small Flute Ensemble: 3 - 5 PerformersH Large Flute Ensemble: 6 or more Performers

#### 11.30am: 16 Years and under - Maximum time: 7 minutes

I Duet: 2 flutes only

J Duet plus One: 2 flutes + one other instrument

O Small Flute Ensemble: 3 - 5 Performers - minimum 3 <u>flute</u> players

**P** Large Flute Ensemble: 6 or more Performers - minimum 6 <u>flute</u> players

#### 2.45pm: Novice Sections - Maximum time: 10 minutes

**Q** Novice Small Flute Ensemble: 3 - 5 Performers - minimum 3 <u>flute</u> players

**R** Novice Large Flute Ensemble: 6 or more Performers - minimum 6 <u>flute</u> players

#### 3.15pm: Open Sections - Maximum time: 10 minutes

S Duet: 2 flutes only

**T** Duet plus One: 2 flutes + one other instrument

**U** Small Flute Ensemble: 3 - 5 Performers - minimum 3 <u>flute</u> players

V Large Flute Ensemble: 6 or more Performers - minimum 6 flute players

Please note that a minimum number of 3 <u>flute</u> players are required in the Small Flute Ensembles, and a minimum number of 6 flute players in the Large Flute Ensembles.

Piano accompaniment and /or rhythm section may be used except in Duet for 2 flutes only sections. Any other instruments may be included as long as minimum flute numbers are performing.
